Hotspot Analysis

Corporate facilities are scored for their exposure to relevant climate hazards and benchmarked relative to a country's facilities based on Four Twenty Seven's global dataset.

The Hotspot Analysis assesses exposure to six climate hazards at the facility level: heat stress, water stress, floods, hurricanes and typhoons, sea level rise, and wildfires.

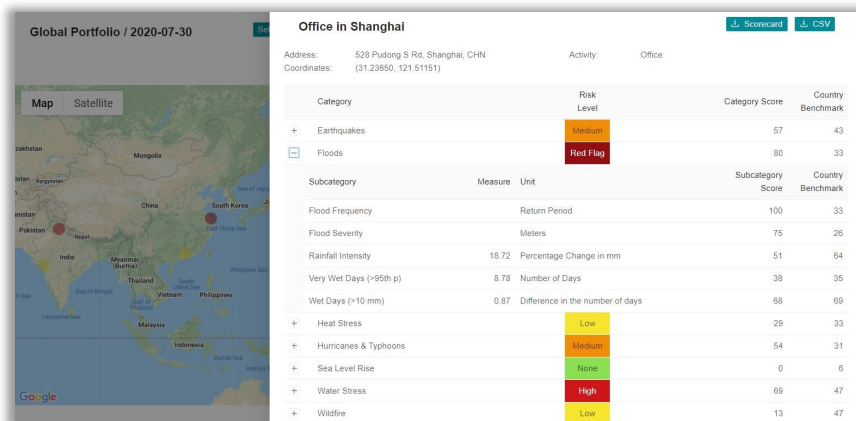
Use Cases

Methodology

- Models assess projected exposure to climate hazards from 2030 to 2040 for each facility
- Flood risk and sea level rise risk assessed at 90x90m granularity
